Courtesy Rules

- 3. Dumpsters by bath and pole barn.
- 4. Washing Units: We use well water. Please do not wash your vehicles.
- 5. Please, no washing of dishes or utensils in the restrooms.
- Pets must be on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your pet; this includes the beach and tent area. Do not leave a pet tied up or inside your RV when you leave.
- 7. Parents are responsible for the actions and behavior of their children.
- 8. We are not responsible for loss or damage of property.
- Campers or their guests failing to follow these rules or any directive given by the campground staff may be expelled from the campground with forfeiture of fees. (Michigan Public Act 162 of 1999.)

- 11. Fires must be in park fire pots. If there are none, ask at office do not take pots from the tent area. Fire pots are not allowed on front lawn.
- Check-out is 11:30 AM. Every hour past 11:30 AM, the charge is \$5.00. After 5:00 PM, full day price.

Mackinac Bridge

Since 1864, when building a bridge across the straits was first proposed, until November 1, 1957, Mighty Mac was known as the "bridge that couldn't be built." On that day, the U.P. and lower Michigan were permanently tied together. There were more obstacles overcome and problems solved in designing and building the Mackinac Bridge than any comparable project. Yet it is one of the most beautiful structures ever built and the most beautiful in the U.P. Thirty-three foundations resting on bedrock support the 4-mile-long uninterrupted steel superstructure. The 2 huge tower foundations descend more than 200 feet below the water and were built out on the water using boats, barges and ships, handling the men, machinery and materials.
